

Center for Global Engagement: Commencement Regalia Policy

The following guidelines detail the Center for Global Engagement's (CGE) policies regarding commencement regalia:

Study Abroad & Off-Campus Study Students

- Students who participated in an approved semester-long or dual-degree St. Norbert College study abroad or off-campus study program sponsored by CGE will receive a sash that depicts the flag of the host country.
 - If the student participated in two approved semester-long programs in two different countries, the student will receive a double (split) sash.
 - If the student is an international student who participated in two approved semester-long programs in two different countries, the student will receive a triple (split) sash.
 - Students who studied abroad for a semester but did not participate in an approved St. Norbert College program will not receive a sash.
 - Students who participated in the approved semester-long semester programs in the U.S. (i.e., Washington Media Institute, American University) will receive a sash that depicts the Washington, D.C. flag.
- Students who participated in an approved Global Seminar (short-term program during the J-Term or summer) sponsored by CGE will receive a patch that depicts the flag of the host country.
 - Students who participated in multiple Global Seminars will receive one patch per program.
 - Students who participated in a short-term program not sponsored by CGE will not receive a patch.
 - Students will receive only one patch if the Global Seminar took place in more than one country. The Faculty Director is responsible for identifying an appropriate patch.
- Since CGE does not sponsor student teaching programs abroad, CGE does not provide commencement regalia for students who participated in a student teaching program abroad.
 - Students should consult with the Discipline Coordinator for Education regarding the department's commencement regalia policy.

International Students

- International students who successfully complete a dual-degree program or earn a bachelor's or master's degree from St. Norbert College will receive a sash that depicts the flag of their home country.
 - If the international student participated in an approved semester-long program sponsored by CGE, the student will receive a double (split) sash.
 - If the international student participated in two approved semester-long programs sponsored by CGE, the student will receive a triple (split) sash.

Additional Notes

- CGE manages the ordering of and payment for commencement regalia. Students are responsible for retrieving the commencement regalia at the annual Cap & Gown Ceremony.
 - If students are unable to attend the Cap & Gown Ceremony, the student is responsible for retrieving the commencement regalia.
