Students were asked to respond to several open-ended questions which included:

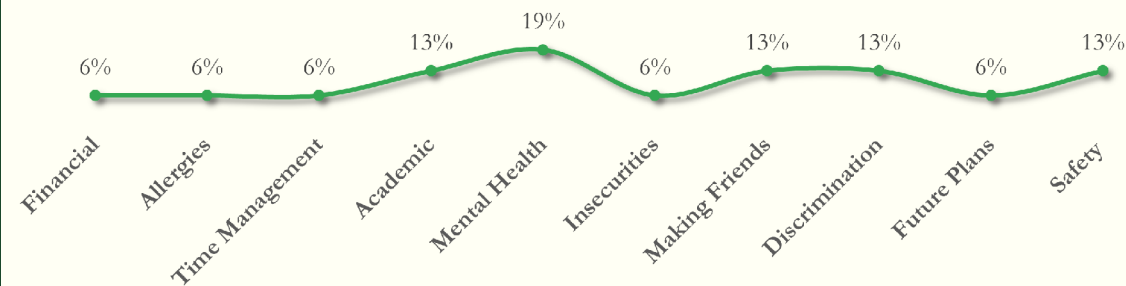
- Are there other worries or concerns that you'd like people at St. Norbert College to know about?

Common Themes

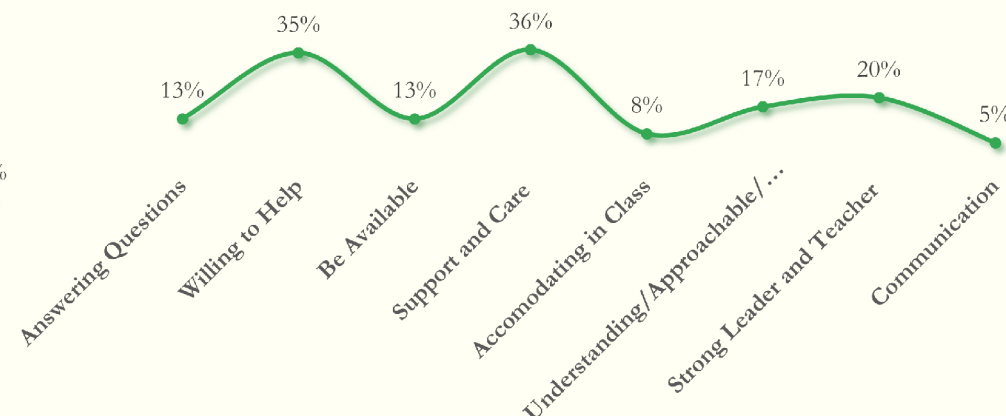
* Percentages are taken from the number of students who responded to the specific question

Of the first-year SNC students who answered the question, the most reported worries involved **mental health**. Most students, 67%, reported not having any worries.

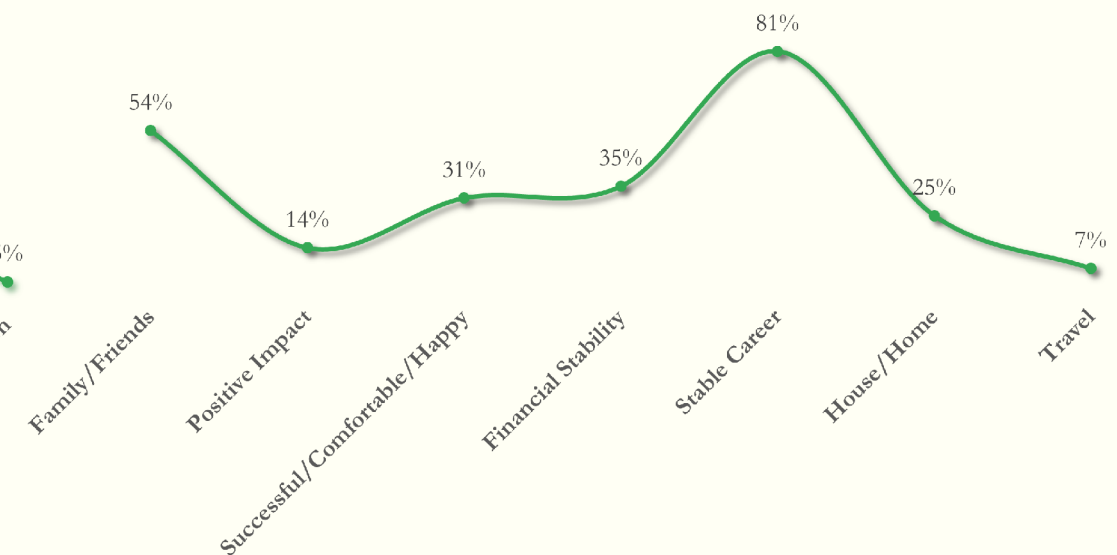
"My anxiety can get the best of me sometimes..."
